## Information about our Cambodian NGO partners.

### They selected your student for sponsorship.

*Friendship with Cambodia's sponsored students are chosen by local Cambodian non-profit organizations that work with poor rural families across Cambodia. Friendship with Cambodia partners with these NGOs and sometimes funds their women's self-help groups. Here is some background information about the activities of each of these NGOs.*

**To find your student's NGO Partner:** Match their Student Code (on the back of their photo) to the code below. Some student codes are abbreviations for the NGO's name and some are the name of the District they are from.

**BOR** (Boribor District)

**KRK** (Phnom Kravanh District)

**TPH** (Tbeng Meanchey District)

**AEC - Action for Environment and Community** in Kompong Chhnang and Pursat Provinces teaches community-based forest management and helps the poorest families.

**CHL** (Chulkiri District)

**RPI** (Rolear P'ier District)

**CCD - Community Capacities for Development** in Kompong Chhnang Province works with poor and vulnerable people living along the Tonle Sap Lake and helps these communities defend their fishing rights and organize women's self-help groups.

**CLA - Children and Life Association** in Prey Veng Province has a Child Protection Network, gives workshops in maternal health, HIV/AIDS prevention, nutrition, and family violence; offers savings groups, microfinance, business mentoring, and gives training in growing home vegetable gardens, poultry and pig raising, and organic composting.

**COCD - Cambodian Organization for Children and Development** in Pursat and Kampot Provinces has self-help groups, cow banks, income-generating projects, vocational and agricultural trainings, empowerment trainings, and health services.

**KPT** (Kampot District)

**SSN** (Srey Snam District)

**DKA - Day Ku Aphiwat (Development Partners)** in Kampot Province and four other provinces organizes women's networks and builds their capacity, helps the poorest women form self-help groups, organizes youth, community organizing and development, and natural resources management.

**KRV** (Phnom Kravanh District)

**AK - Anakot Komar (Children's Future)** in Pursat Province has self-help groups, improves commune governance, offers agricultural training, job skills training, literacy classes, cares for families living with AIDS, and advocates for children's rights and community forests.

**PBL** (Prasath Ballang District)

**ROV** (Rovieng District)

**TBM** (Tbeng Meanchey District)

**OPKC - Organization to Promote Kui Culture** in Kompong Thom and Preah Vihear Provinces helps Kui indigenous families and registers indigenous communities' communal land.

**SAM** (Samraong District)

**TRP** (Trapeang Prasath District)

**CDA - Children's Development Association** in Oddar Meanchey Province sets up microcredit programs and community-based forest management.

**SDN** (Sandan District)

**EHE - Environmental and Health Education** in Kompong Thom Province does community organizing, natural resources management, and economic development.

**SNU** (Snuol District)

**SIPN - Snoul Indigenous Peoples Network** in Kratie Province forms networks to protect exploitation of the indigenous people and their community forest and farms from illegal logging and land grabbing.
